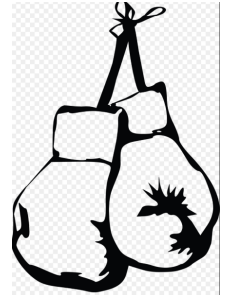


Congratulations Justice
