FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What will I learn during the day?

Each day is designed around an essential question. Students will have an extended opportunity to explore topics with real world applications. Teachers will be communicating with their classes during the weeks leading up to their Innovation Day to explain what students can expect to be learning.

What if I have a spare?

Students who have a spare will not be expected to attend school on the day connected to their spare. We do encourage students to use this time for their own independent study.
